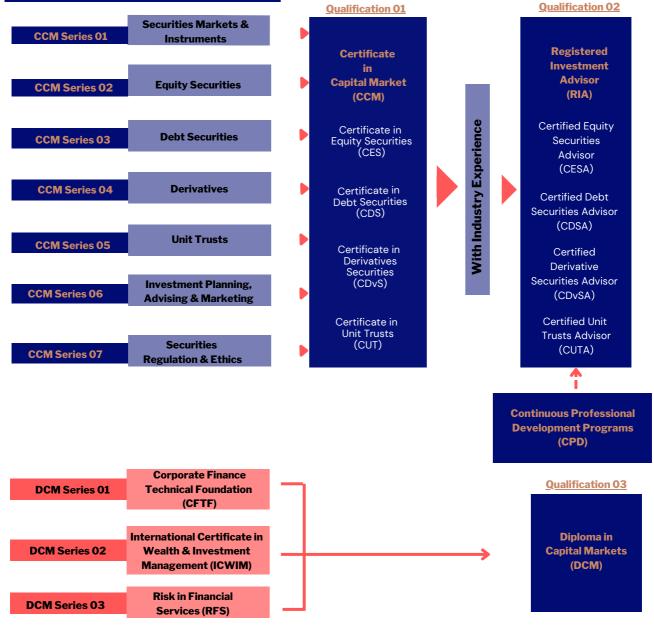


CERTIFICATE IN CAPITAL MARKETS (CCM)

AN EXCELLENT OPPORTUNITY TO BUILD A REWARDING CAREER IN CAPITAL MARKETS

Qualification Framework (QF)



The QF has established the Certificate in Capital Markets (CCM) as the basic securities market certification, and is mandatory to be licensed as a Registered Investment Advisor (RIA) in Sri Lanka. This QF provides for separate certifications for asset classes to accommodate equity, debt, derivatives and unit trusts and enhance the RIA qualification to an apex qualification in the securities industry.

The main objective of this QF is to ensure that financial industry professionals have a minimum level of proficiency to perform their job functions. This is an essential prerequisite for developing a viable securities industry and safe guarding the interests of the investors.

Obtaining this qualification will be useful for recruitment in the areas of Banking, Stock brokering, Money brokering, Fund management, Investment banking, Corporate financing, Venture capital, Insurance, Leasing & Finance, Accounting, Valuation, Financial consulting etc. CCM is also an entry qualification to register for Diploma in Capital Markets (DCM)

The above highlighted table indicate the specific Series that form each Certification. Series 1, Series 6 and Series 7 are common and required for all the Certifications. In addition to these Series, each certification requires a specialized series on the specific asset class or instrument such as equity, debt, derivatives and unit trusts for which the Certification in obtained. CCM contains all asset classes and hence all series are included.

After achieving the Certification with the relevant industry experience, the licenses can be obtained as follows:

Entry Qualifications

The minimum entry requirements to register as a candidate for any of the certifications are as follows:

• GCE Advanced Level examination.

• Bachelors' Degree in a discipline acceptable to the SEC.

• Professional qualifications in a discipline acceptable to the SEC.

Course Details

Commencement

A new batch will commence once a year and/or according to industry requirement.

Duration

Duration to complete CCM will be one year. Lectures will be on Saturdays

Statutory Requirement

In terms of the Securities and Exchange Commission of Sri Lanka (SEC) Act No. 19 of 2021 (as amended), obtaining the Certificate in Capital Markets is a mandatory requirement to function as a Registered Investment Advisor(RIA).

Course Material

Comprehensive lecture material for all Series will be provided before each lecture. Additional study material such as text books, study guides and financial calculator is required to be purchased by the student.



Exemptions

Exemptions are intended to provide waiver due to previous academic or professional training of candidates.

Exemptions are granted on a Series Basis for each certification

A person who has passed the Level II Examination of the Certified Financial Analysts (CFA) program is eligible for exemptions from:

Series 1 - Securities Markets and Instruments

Series 2 - Equity Securities
Series 3 - Debt Securities

Series 4 - Derivatives

Exemptions will NOT be granted for

Series 6 -Financial Planning, Advising and Marketing

Series 7 -Securities Regulation and Ethics

CCM Examinations
